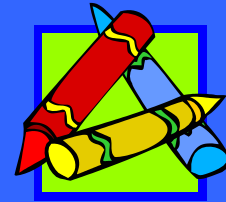
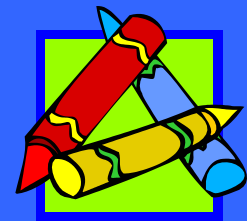

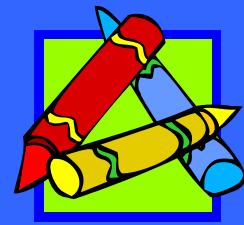
Mom's Morning Out -
1 year old by September 1st
Tuesday and Thursday/8:30am - 12:30pm

Our Mom's Morning Out Program will acclimate your toddler to a learning environment that will spark their interests and encourage them to explore and learn.



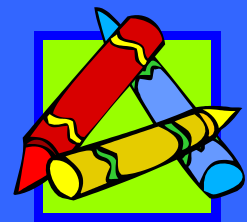
Two Year Olds -
2 years old by September 1st
Monday, Wednesday, Friday/8:30am - 12:30pm
Or Monday - Friday/8:30am - 12:30pm

Our two year old class is designed to build confidence and encourage independence as they master skills designed for them to achieve. They will focus on sharing, walking in line and following directions as well numbers, shapes and colors. They will learn a bible verse and bible story each month. This class will be visited by community helpers.



3 Year Olds -
3 years old by September 1st
Monday - Friday/8:30am - 12:30pm

Our three year old class develops preschooler's eagerness to experiment and learn through circle time, pretend play and fine and gross motor skilled activities where they participate with others and as individuals. They will learn the alphabet - to identify each letter, the sound it makes, a word it starts with and to trace the letter. They will learn numbers, shapes, colors, a monthly bible verse and story, and how to spell and write their name. This class will participate in field trips and be visited by community helpers.



4 Year Olds -
4 years old by September 1st
Monday - Friday/8:30am - 12:30pm

Our four year old class expands and strengthens their socialization skills -- how to compromise, be respectful of others, and problem-solve as well as developing their independence and decision making. They will practice writing and have one homework sheet a week. They will learn their short and long vowels and using phonics they will be able to read a short book by mid year. They will share in daily devotionals, learn a bible verse and story each month and partake in resurrection eggs and communion. This class will participate in field trips and be visited by community helpers.
